3. Send NAFGA the recommendation letter and the application form to NAFGA secretariat (*zhangxiangtraining@163.com*) **before Nov.3rd** and NAFGA secretariat will contact the Chinese embassy in your country for further procedures.
4. NAFAG secretariat will get the confirmation of the application from Chinese embassy, and inform you of the participation as soon as possible.
