| Training Content | <p>The Seminar will be held online and adopt a combination of lectures, group discussions, case studies and Virtual Study Tour. Focusing on sustainable development and management of bamboo and rattan resources, the tentative lectures include: A brief introduction to China and its culture (including experience sharing on fighting COVID-19 and poverty alleviation); China's foreign aid policies and development; China's bamboo resources, industry and policies; Bamboo resources cultivation and management techniques; Bamboo shoot cultivation and processing and products development; Bamboo properties, bamboo products and standards; Bamboo and rattan brand development and market development; Bamboo construction; Bamboo charcoal production, application and standards; Reform of forest property system-taking bamboo forest as an example; International trade development of bamboo and rattan commodities; Rattan resource cultivation, processing and trade; Anji bamboo industry value chain. At the same time, participants will be arranged virtual study tour to the "Chinese Bamboo Township" in Zhejiang Province and Sichuan Province to learn and exchange advanced experiences in the sustainable development and management of bamboo and rattan resources.</p> <p>There will be a national reporting section with interactive discussions during the seminar, so the participants are advised to prepare relevant information in advance for sharing and discussion. In this section participants are invited to briefly introduce their countries, as well as the sustainable development and management of bamboo and rattan resources in their countries. During the interactive discussions, the organizer will invite senior officials from ICBR, and INBAR, and senior managers from China Bamboo and Rattan Industry National Innovation Alliance to discuss the possibility of multilateral and bilateral cooperation. The participants are advised learn about the status quo and challenges of forestry cooperation, especially on bamboo, between their countries and China in advance, and think about the possibility of enhancing cooperation. We will also consult the participants on their expectations for the seminar in a bid to make the seminar better oriented according to their needs.</p> <p>By this seminar, the participants will learn the status of bamboo and rattan resources and industries, both in China and the globe, acquire the innovative technologies in sustainable development, deeply and directly recognize the comprehensive benefits of bamboo and rattan in economy, community and environment. We expected that participants could apply what they learnt in China to their countries, to make suggestions and proposals for green and inclusive increase on B&R sustainable development and management according to local circumstances. As a result, we hope to promote the South-South cooperation between China and belt and road countries in bamboo and rattan sector, to generally realize the SDGs throughout the world.</p> | | |

| About the Organizer | <p>The International Centre for Bamboo and Rattan (ICBR) was approved to be established in 2000 by State Commission Office for Public Sector Reform, the Ministry of Finance, the Ministry of Science and Technology, which was a non-profit research institution under the National Forestry and Grassland Administration (NFGA). Its mission is to directly serve the first China-based intergovernmental international organization - the International Bamboo and Rattan Organization (INBAR) - in supporting and cooperating with the work of INBAR to promote sustainable development of the international bamboo and rattan industries.</p> <p>ICBR's main responsibilities and tasks are: to launch scientific research in bamboo and rattan for better resource conservation, development and utilization; to carry out international cooperation and exchanges in related fields for INBAR member countries; to train senior professionals by disciplinary and personnel development; to spread out scientific R&D, technological services and promoting use of the products to speed up the bamboo industry; to unfold both international and domestic technical training; and to provide logistics support services to headquarter of INBAR.</p> <p>Since 2005, sponsored by Ministry of Commerce, ICBR organized 52 international seminars and training programs on bamboo & rattan and desertification combat; it has trained a total of 1803 senior government officials (including 23 ministers), business executives and senior technical staff from 83 countries. These programs play a very important role in promoting the development of bamboo and rattan sector and desertification combat worldwide, and have been highly valued by participants, ambassadors and NGOs. It is noteworthy that President Xin Jinping sent an official congratulatory letter for the 20th anniversary of INBAR, and Premier Li Keqiang met with the Ministers who joined the Ministerial Workshop on Bamboo and Rattan. ICBR and the former Minister of State of Ethiopia published an initiative on the establishment of a "Sino-Africa Bamboo Center", while later on, President Xi Jinping mentioned it in the Eight Major Initiatives of the FOCAC Beijing Summit. Besides, Mr. Ban Ki-moon, the former Secretary General of the United Nations sent a congratulatory message for International Seminar on the Combating Desertification for African Countries in 2011.</p> |
